DESCRIPTION:

ISLAND LATEX TINTING COLOR is a water-based colorant made from selected high-quality pigments dispersed finely to ensure live color tone and tinting strength. They are colorfast and ready to be mixed with all latex-type of paints.

USE:

For tinting latex-based paint intended for exterior and interior application.

COLOR:

Available in 10 varied Tinting Colors (refer to Price List)

*Hansa Yellow & Permanent Red are recommended only for interior use.

APPLICATION:

Stir well. Add the desired tinting color to the paint. Mix thoroughly to avoid color streaks or lumps. Limit addition to a maximum of 1/4 liter total tinting color(s) per gallon of latex paint.

REDUCTION:

Use at package consistency

PACKAGING:

¼ L and 1L lithographed round can

SHELF LIFE:

2 years in unopened container

STORAGE & DISPOSAL:

Keep container tightly sealed. Do not store above 35 °C. Must not be disposed together with household garbage. Do not allow product to reach sewage system. Disposal must be according to government regulations.
