ROOFKOTE 370 METAPRIME GRAY

DESCRIPTION:

ROOFKOTE 370 METAPRIME GRAY is an emulsionbased primer coating that maximizes adhesion property of Roofkote roofing paint.

USE:

Recommended as primer coat to galvanized iron sheet that is new, dulled and uncorroded.

COLOR:

Gray

FINISH:

Flat

APPLICATION:







Brush

REDUCTION:

Normally, no reduction needed

DRYING TIME:

Dry to recoat : 2-4 hours

COVERAGE:

Approximately 25-30 sq. m. / 4L over flat GI sheet

SURFACE PREPARATION:

New GI dulled, uncorroded – dust off dirt; wipe off with thinner to remove oil/grease. Dry surface thoroughly, then apply one (1) coat Roofkote 370Metaprime Gray. No extra treatment of new GI roof is necessary.

SUGGESTED FINISH COAT:

Roofkote Acrylic Roof Paint

PACKAGING:

4L plastic container

SHELF LIFE:

3 years in unopened container

STORAGE & DISPOSAL:

Keep container tightly sealed. Do not store above 35 °C. Must not be disposed together with household garbage. Do not allow product to reach sewage system. Disposal must be according to government regulations.
